Mattress Recycling - August 6, 2022


Eau Claire County is sponsoring a mattress/box spring recycling event. So if you are looking to get **rid** of that old mattress, recycle it rather than take to the landfill. The cost is \$20 for drop-off or you can pay an extra \$5.00 and have someone pick it up at your house. This is cheaper than most disposal fees and it keeps your mattress out of the landfill. Recycling Questions/Information...Did you know?

One huge issue with curbside recycling is plastic bags as they clog the recycling sorting machines and are a hazard to the process and the workers. ALL recycling should be loose in your blue bin. Plastic film such as ziplocs, toilet paper plastic cover, bread bags, bubble wrap and grocery bags can be dropped off at the plastic film drop-off sites at Festival Foods. But **NEVER** put your recycling in a plastic bag.

Thanks to our crew of amazing volunteers, the 12th annual Daylily Dig for Malawi was a huge success. Despite the inclement weather Saturday afternoon which pretty much shut down the dig, we had our second best dig ever. We grossed \$7400, just \$600 short of our record gross of \$8000 from last year.

TV coverage by WEAU/13 and being included in the calendar of events in Volume One helped bring a number of first-time people to the dig. A Thrivent Action Grant enabled us to provide some of the food needed for the volunteers.

One of the reasons it was so successful was the fact that the gardens were in such great condition. That was made possible by volunteers this past month helping weed the gardens and move plants. Thank you to all who were able to help!

Now we begin the fun of preparing the gardens for next year's dig! We get to help Tim Fehr divide and "line out" the registered plants that everyone comes to the daylily dig to acquire. Without this work, we won't have enough good plants to give away next year!

Watch for another SignUp Genius from Grace and encourage others to sign up. The work is simple and rewarding. Greg and Tim will be working alongside of you, so you don't have to bring any gardening skills to the experience!
